

Covid-19 Notifications

Updated as of 7/4/2020

We are aware of the concerns regarding covid-19 and would like to assure everyone that we are doing what we can to help keep everyone healthy and safe. We are staying up to date with the [CDC guidelines](#) and are reinforcing recommended protocols. This includes:

- Extra cleaning, sanitizing, disinfecting
- Limiting entrance into the facility
- Keeping groups small
- Distancing as much as possible
- Extra handwashing / making sure we're washing properly
- Face covers required during the pickup/dropoff of your child
- Offering hand sanitizer upon entrance and exit of the facility (supervised for children)
- Doing extra health checks upon entrance/exit of the facility
- Monitoring for any possible illnesses throughout the day
- Logging daily temperature checks for individual children

Some items that can not be easily cleaned have been removed from the play area, ex: stuffed toys. No events or field trips will be held during this time. Outdoor play (in the backyard) will be allowed weather permitting. Children will be spaced out as much as possible during meal and snack times, nap times, and group times. Items will be labeled/assigned per child in at least one way (name, color, number, shape) wherever possible to help reduce the chances of things being shared and germs spreading, ex: cups, nap mats, cubbies, etc. We ask that you take home your child's bedding each day and wash or bring new bedding. We do have Zoom Consults available so you can meet us and see our facility before you bring your child. If you have any questions, concerns, or ideas please do not hesitate to say something and your concerns will be addressed as soon as possible. Please note that we are unable to accept any person into the facility whom has shown any symptoms in the prior 14 days, for the safety and well being of your family and ours. Alternatively, if we experience any symptoms, we will be in contact with you.
